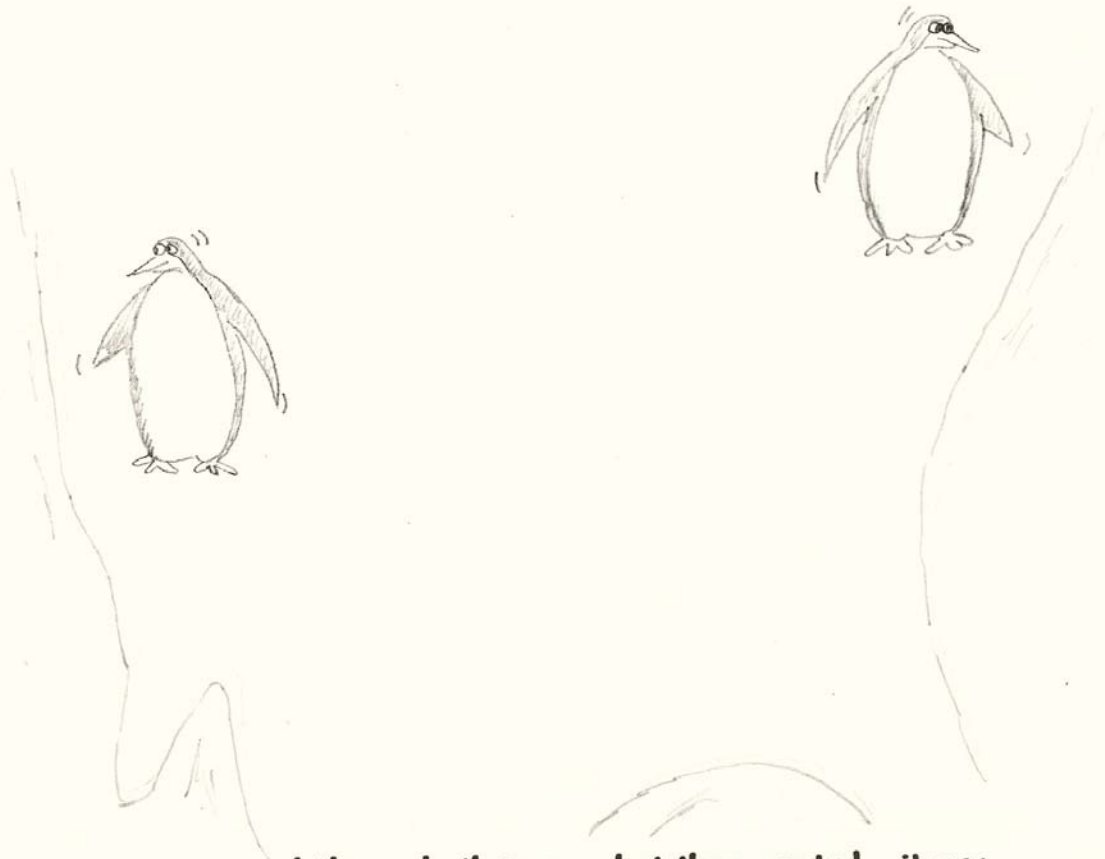


The Story of

sides of an iceberg.**



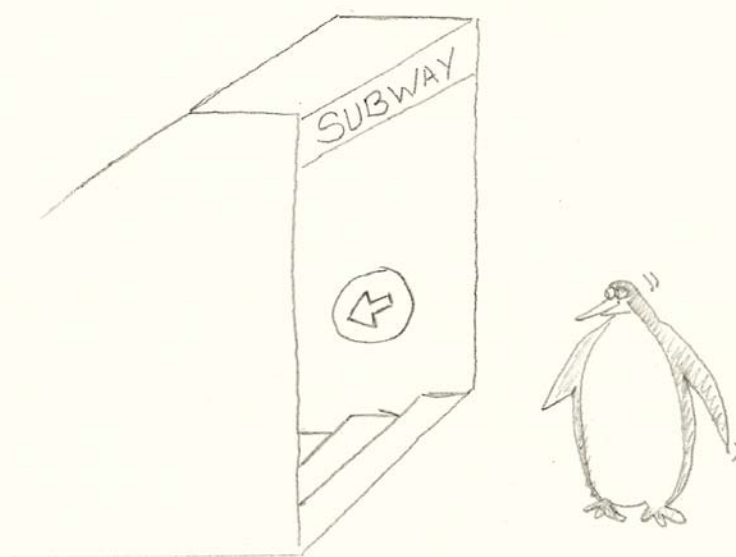
**Margo and Henry both knew what they wanted- it was

Henry was so excited to read this.

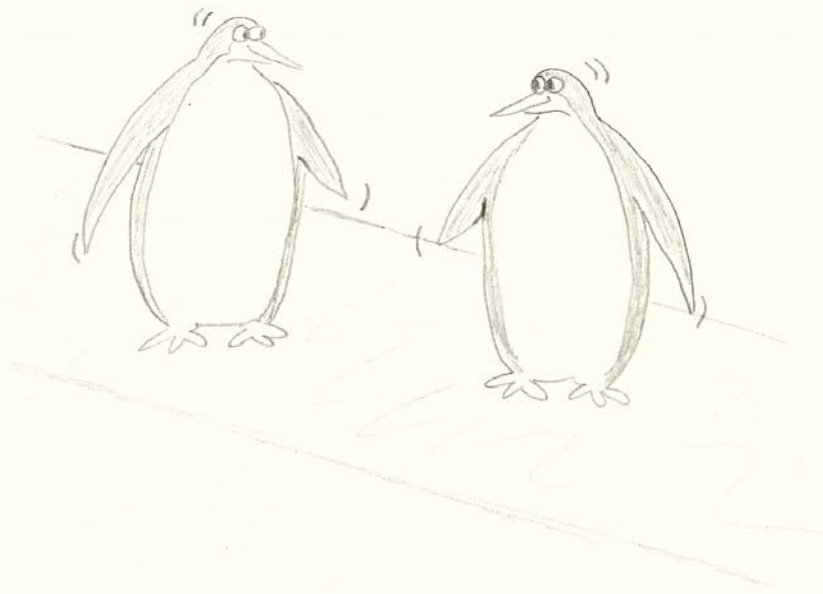


He wrote back to Margo as quickly as his flippers could type. The note said he would make his way down to see her at any cost.

The night before they were to meet, both Margo and Henry were so nervous that neither of them could sleep.

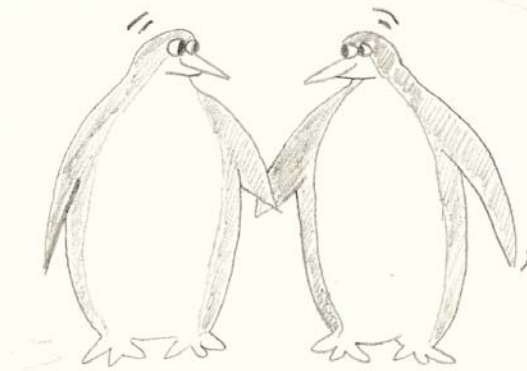


All night long, all they could think was what the new day would bring.

flipper in flipper.

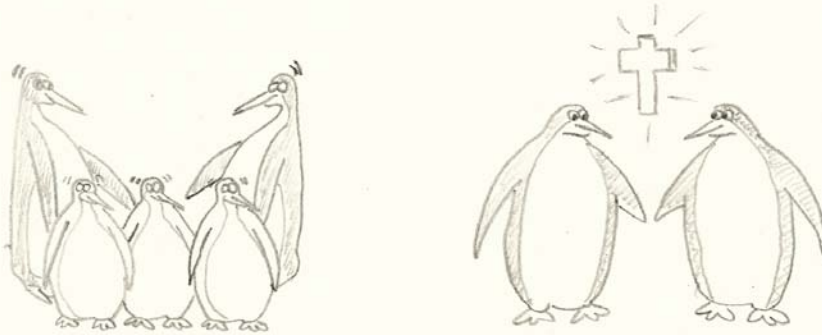


And even though they walked among all the other
penguins. . . all they could see was each other.

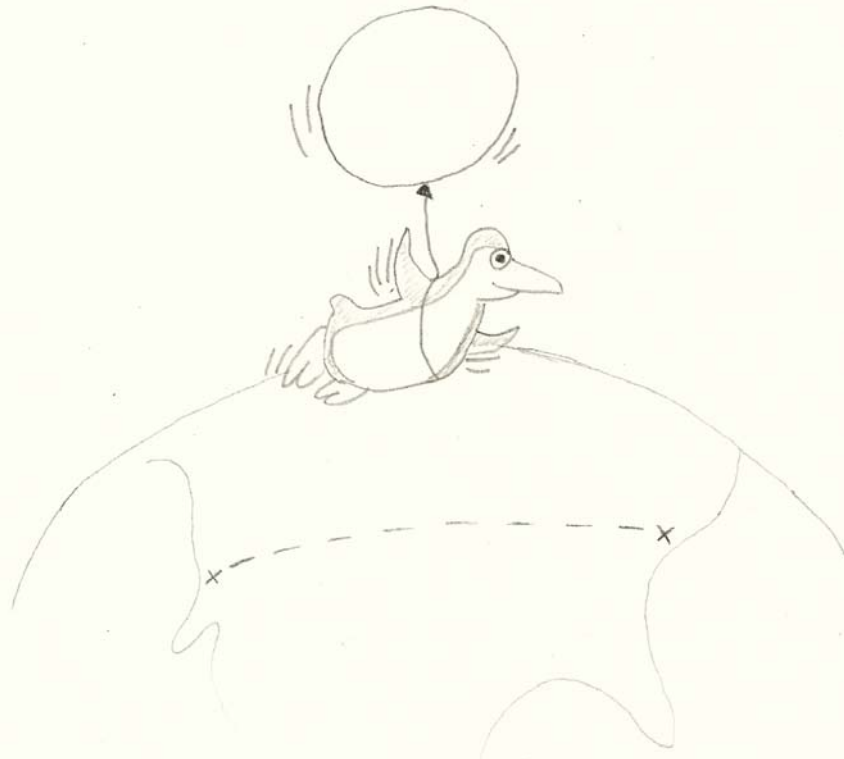


**After they had dinner with Margo's family, it was time

They talked about their hopes- their dreams- and most importantly- their faith in God.

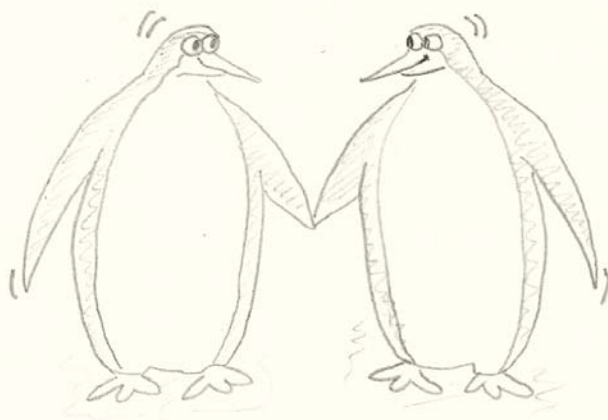


**Henry even made a trip out to visit Margo

This became a very important moment for the two penguins. Margo had to choose if she wanted to start her life with Henry now, or later. . .



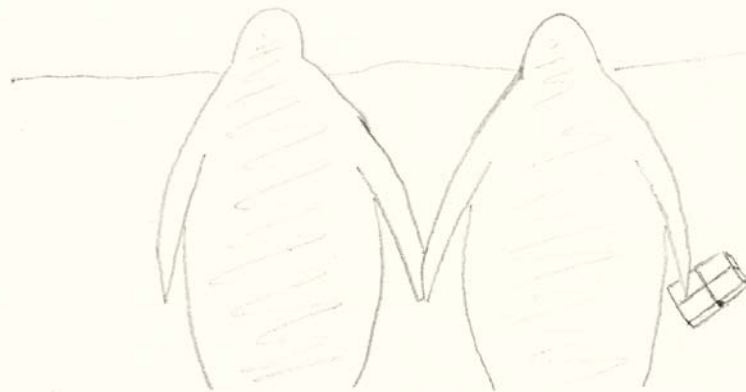
Margo chose now!

And so it continued to be that Margo and Henry would be together. As time moved forward, so did Margo's and Henry's love for each other.

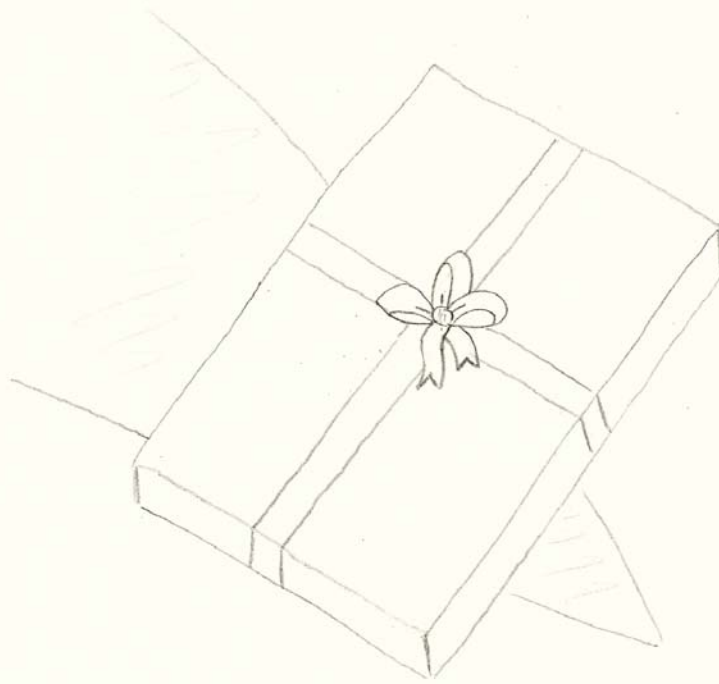


Margo and Henry made a commitment to each other that they would always be together and treat each other with respect and love and that their love would forever be.

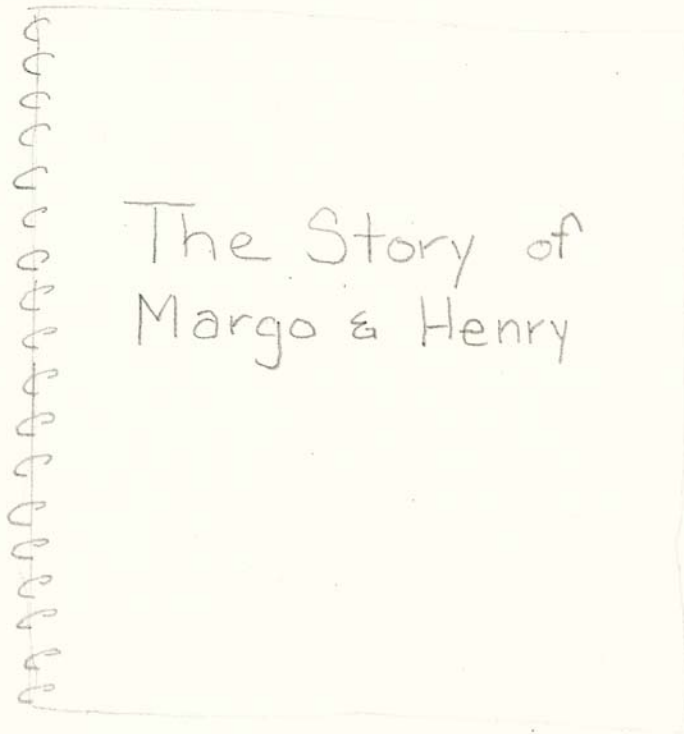
Just after they had been together for six months, Henry wanted to take Margo to a very special place.



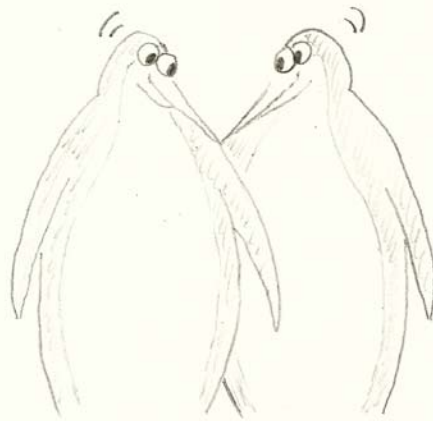
So Henry took Margo back to the place they first went together.



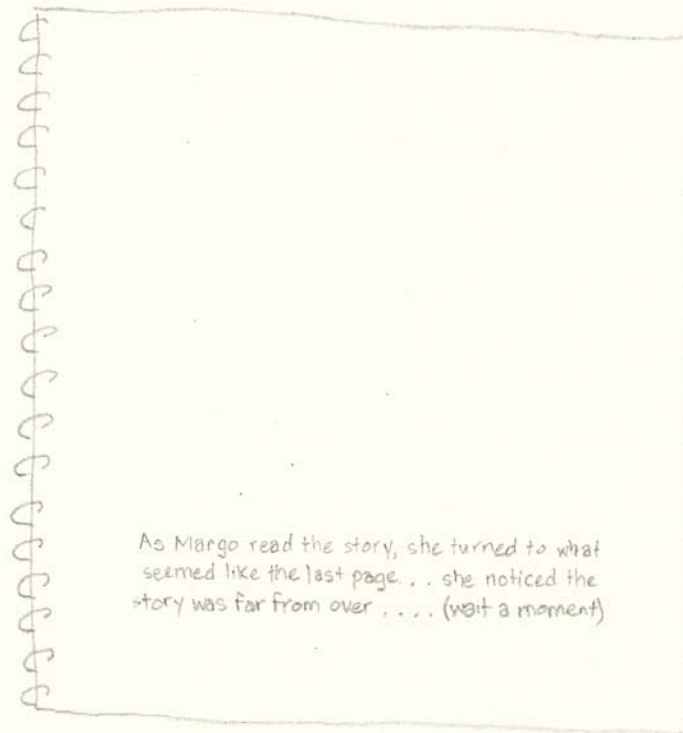
**While sitting there together on the beach-

Henry got on one knee before the precious Margo and promised her all that he had. Henry promised to be loyal to her for all his life and to give to her all that she may ever need.



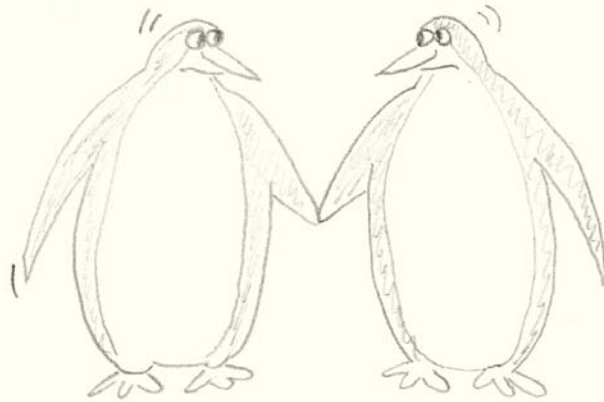
And just before he was finished-
